It seems to me that scrambles promote slow play. I'm sure that's because my groups use get early times and are done, had lunch, home between 12-1 and got the rest of the day to do whatever.

Feel all courses were good.

Drop Crestwicke because:

1. Unfriendly attitude.
2. Price not worth \$60.

Please emphasize ready golf at the fall banquet. There are so many members that don't seem to notice they are holding up the whole field by playing slow.

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I would like to propose we vote on limiting how many tee times a coordinator can request before the rest of the members. I propose a coordinator can request a tee time preference for 4 events only. I would suggest the events in the month they are coordinating their event . For example, if a guy coordinates his event in July, he can request tee times early for the events in July. Before and after July, they use the same time lines as the other members.

I think Crestwicke is too expensive for the service we receive there. The employees do not seem friendly and the pro shop is always closed by GR time the afternoon session is over.

List the correct prices on schedule. Courses charge more than what is listed. Some courses too expensive.

Impress on Crestwicke CC to either reduce their fees and/or treat us like they appreciate us playing there instead of being "a stream of income". If they don't get the message, then reduce the number of times we play to once per season!

Development a plan to enter scores online.
